II. APPLICANT: Malaga County Water District

#### III. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project will: 1) trench, border, and resurface the walking path; 2) install work-out stations along the walking path; 3) replace drinking fountains along the walking path; 4) re-roof the BBQ area cover; 5) replace the gazebo lighting; 6) install electrical outlets for park rental use; 7) improve playground surface.



## X. BACKGROUND INFORMATION / RECENT PROJECT SUMMARY:

- A. The project will provide safer, Americans with Disabilities (ADA) compliant and upgraded recreational facilities for the community.
- B. The Malaga Water Well Upgrades project was funded in December, 2016. The project is scheduled to be completed in August of 2018. The District was able to obtain funding through other sources for a portion of the work, reducing the District's financial contribution and requiring a scope modification.
- C. The Malaga Arriaga Community Center Roof and A/C project is scheduled to be funded by the Board of Supervisors in December, 2017. The estimated completion date is June 13, 2019.
- D. The most recent completed CDBG project in Malaga, Malaga No. 3 and No. 5 Water Test Wells, was funded in the fall of 2013. The project was completed in September, 2016. The project required one scope modification and two time extensions, extending the project by 20 months.
- E. A petition with approximately 136 signatures was submitted in support of the application.
