#### <u>OPERATIONAL STATEMENT – CHESTNUT AVE INDUSTRIAL SITE PLAN SUBMITTAL</u>

The Chestnut Avenue Industrial Development proposes to construct an approximately 243,000 square foot concrete tilt-up shell building with (4) proposed offices and up to (4) potential lease spaces. The ultimate user(s) of this building are currently unknown and are typically not known until the shell building construction is completed and a lease is signed with the future tenant(s). At that point, a building permit for tenant improvements (TI) will be applied for and pulled with the County indicating the user and their specific TI requirements.


Operational times are typical of other warehouse style projects which are typically Monday-Friday 6am-6pm—however, some users require 24/7 operation. Customer visits to the property are limited since these buildings are not typically sales buildings, but rather warehouses for distribution of goods.

The number of employees is currently unknown; however, we have provided 154 standard 9'x19' parking stalls and (8) ADA stalls for employee parking. In addition to the standard automotive parking, we are providing 51 12'x55' truck parking stalls. The proposed parking spaces and drive aisles will be constructed of asphalt concrete (AC) pavement and the proposed loading docks will be constructed of Portland cement concrete (PCC) pavement.

Access to the site is provided off of East Chestnut Avenue and we are proposing a private, 50' wide asphalt road to service the proposed building. The proposed site will not produce excessive noise, glare, dust, or odor. Water supply will be provided by the Malaga Water District and average water usage is approximately 20 gallons per day per 1,000 square foot of floor area which yields approximately 5,000 gallons per day.

The site will have pole lighting to illuminate the parking areas, exterior building lighting to illuminate the loading docks, and typical streetlights along the private access road. Landscaping will be provided in all undeveloped areas such that the potential for erosion and dust is limited. Fencing will be provided around the perimeter of the site to keep the site secure.

The following are comments concerning the subject application:

- A draft Capital Improvement Plan was developed and submitted to the District in January 2019. The recommendation was that the District needed to construct a replacement well immediately and that each of the proposed annexations would need to dedicate a new well site to the District. Please also see attached the recommendation regarding water supply dated June 29, 2020.
- 2. The proposed development is within the boundaries of the Malaga County Water District. An existing 14 inch water main exists along the frontage of the property. An existing 18 inch sewer main exists along the frontage of the property.
- 3. The proposed development is a 470,000 square foot warehouse and a 187,000 square foot industrial warehouse located on the north side of Central Avenue west of Minnewawa Avenue. Water supply to address warehouse needs are typically not high, however, fire flow requirements are significant. The application states that the use of the facility is unknown. The site plan includes 433 vehicle parking spaces and 143 truck parking spaces. Based on the review of water supply of the Malaga County Water District submitted in January 2019, the water supply may not be adequate to serve the proposed new development.
- 4. The site plan is silent on sanitary sewer estimates. The excess capacity of the existing sewer main is not known. The proposed sanitary sewer demands are not defined. It may be possible that the developer would be required to construct a private lift station in order to access the existing sewer main, if capacity was available.
- 5. Based on the information provided, it is not recommended that a will-serve letter is provided to the proposed development until a specific schedule of the construction of a new water supply well for the Malaga County Water District is defined. In addition, the available capacity of the existing sewer main should be estimated to determine what limits may be required to any new sanitary sewer connection.

- 6. At such time that sufficient water supply is available and sanitary sewer demands are defined, the proposed development would be required to submit an application for service and follow the steps outlined in the Malaga County Water District development checklist to obtain the required permits and services. The applicant may obtain a copy of the checklist from the District Office at 3580 S. Frank Street, Fresno, CA 93725.
- The developer shall be responsible for constructing connections to the District's sewer and water system in accordance with District requirements and standards. The applicant must submit utility plans that clearly identify the location of water, sewer, landscaping facilities, and drainage areas.
- o MCWD facilities shall be protected and accessible at all times.
- The developer shall be required to pay all applicable District fees in accordance with the rates in effect at the time of payment. If water or sewer improvements are proposed, District fees include a deposit of \$1,000 required for engineering, legal, and administrative fees. Upon receipt of the plans for review, the final fees will be determined. A copy of the current Master Schedule of Fees, Charges, and Recovered Costs is available at the District Office at 3580 S. Frank Street, Fresno, CA 93725.
- Water services with meters and backflow prevention devices will be required for the facility in accordance with District Standards.
- The site will require a Non Residential Waste Discharge Permit for sewer service. The site will had require pretreatment facilities in accordance with current ordinances. The applicant must submit an application for a Non Residential Waste Discharge Permit prior determination of the requirements that may be necessary to meet the regulatory requirements of the Malaga County Water District. Specific information regarding all waste streams that are planned for the site will be required for review. Review and approval of the information and the applicant's proposed pretreatment facilities will be required prior to allowing the development to proceed.
- Storm water shall not be discharged to the sanitary sewer system.
- Fees associated with District review of the construction of improvements shall be determined upon receipt of the plans for construction and an engineer's opinion of probable construction cost for the water and sewer improvements.
- o The applicant is responsible to determine if there are requirements of the fire department.

It is recommended that a plan of action for the water supply source is defined as soon as possible. In addition, the proposed sanitary sewer demands need to be estimated to determine if there are any adverse impacts to the existing wastewater treatment and disposal facilities.

- The County Clerk Department will provide an estimated cost for a candidate statement of 200 words. All statements include the estimated cost of an English and federally mandated Spanish translation. If the district allows 201 to 400 words, the price will double. (E.C. 13307(a)(1))
- 2. The County Clerk Department calculated candidate statement cost estimates for the November 6, 2018, Gubernatorial General District Election for **Malaga County Water District to be \$350.**

The District must state the estimated cost for the candidate statement in Section 2 of the Notice to the County Election Official - Special District Fact Sheet and the district Resolution.

- 3. Fresno County requires each candidate filing a candidate statement to pay in advance (at the time of candidate filing) his or her estimated pro-rata share as a condition of having his or her statement included in the County Voter Information Guide (Board Agenda Item May 24, 2005).

  - B. Provide the Special District's estimated cost.
    - Election Code 13307(c) states "The Local Agency may estimate the total costs of printing, handling, translating, and mailing the candidate's statements filed." It will be the District's responsibility to reimburse all election costs to the Elections Official, regardless of any shortages resulting from a District's incorrect candidate statement estimate.
