RE: Notice of New Requirements under AB 2588, the Air Toxics "Hot Spots"

Information and Assessment Act of 1987

Classification: Industrywide/Small Single Source

District Facility ID: C-2875

As a result of recent changes by the state Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) to its Risk Assessment Guidelines, and the corresponding potential increases in calculated health risk, all facilities that emit air toxics must now be re-evaluated under the AB 2588 Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program. This letter is to notify you that your facility is subject to the state's air toxics emission inventory reporting law and associated fees.

In an effort to assist facilities with the reassessment process, the District has taken numerous steps toward streamlining this process by creating templates and tools. Your facility's annual emissions inventory will be utilized to satisfy the new requirements under the AB 2588 Air Toxics "Hot Spots" Program, thus drastically expediting the process and reducing the cost of compliance with this state law.

It is important to note, no action is required at this time. District staff will be in contact with you during the coming year regarding the reassessment process, if needed.
