c. WWTF Primary DAF Repairs. As previously discussed, the WWTF primary clarifier DAF compressed air tank is corroded and beyond repair. The tank is 27 years old. The DAF system is out of service until replaced or refitted. A staff report is attached that recommends replacing the compressed air tank system with a Nikuni DAF pump

system. Two Nikuni DAF pump systems that refitted compressed air tank systems at the Carmel WWTF and the El Toro WWTF were strongly endorsed. \$233,064.56 remain in the WWTF maintenance and repairs account. The cost of the Nikuni DAF pump system is \$16,900.
