### GENERAL RULES FOR FIRE HYDRANT PERMITS AND METERS

1. The primary use of fire hydrants is to fight fire and must be available for that use at all times.
2. Fire hydrant permits are limited to new construction and for dust control purposes at approved sites only.
3. Fire hydrant use is not permitted for washing purposes on hard surfaces, equipment, or vehicles.
4. Fire hydrant use is not permitted to haul water to locations outside the District sphere of influence.
5. Permittees are responsible for the cost to replace lost, stolen, or damaged meters.
6. Use of a hydrant without a permit and meter is a violation of the Malaga Code subject to severe penalties and fines.
