Great news: the [Boil Water Notice was officially CANCELLED](#) as of **January 29, 2026**. Notices were hand delivered by staff the same day the boil notice was lifted to all of the residential costumers. A copy of the notice is also available on our website.

We know that while the notice was under effect were not easy. Dealing with a water advisory is more than just a minor inconvenience; it's a disruption to the rhythm of your homes, your businesses, and your daily lives. It requires patience to boil every drop, the extra effort of buying bottled water, and the constant vigilance of keeping your families safe.

Today, we celebrate more than just "safe" water—we celebrate the **resilience of our community**. You met this challenge with grace and cooperation, and thanks to that collective effort and the rigorous testing by the Malaga County Water District and state officials, we have emerged stronger.

The taps are clear, the tests are done, and the safety of our water is restored. Thank you for looking out for one another and for your patience while we worked to ensure every drop meets the highest standards.

Moving Forward

You can now return to using your tap water for drinking, cooking, and bathing without any extra steps. The district continues with the routine sampling submitted each week, so rest assured we ensure our water is the best it can be. It's time to put the kettles away and get back to your normal routines!

Note: If you have neighbors who might not see this update online—especially those in apartments or local businesses—please help us spread the word that the water is safe once again.

WATER BILL: Any water bill with outstanding balances of over 60 days will be added to the tax rolls (property taxes) effective June 30, 2026.

¡Excelentes noticias! [El aviso de hervir el agua fue CANCELADO](#) oficialmente el 29 de enero de 2026. El personal entregó los avisos personalmente a todos los clientes residenciales el mismo día en que se levantó la restricción. También pueden encontrar una copia del aviso en nuestro sitio web.

Sabemos que el período en que estuvo vigente el aviso no fue fácil. Lidar con una advertencia sobre el agua es más que una simple molestia; interrumpe la rutina de sus hogares, sus negocios y su vida diaria. Requiere paciencia hervir cada gota de agua, el esfuerzo adicional de comprar agua embotellada y la constante vigilancia para mantener a sus familias seguras.

Hoy celebramos algo más que simplemente tener agua potable: celebramos **la resiliencia de nuestra comunidad**. Afrontaron este desafío con entereza y cooperación, y gracias a ese esfuerzo colectivo y a las rigurosas pruebas realizadas por el Malaga County Water District y los funcionarios estatales, hemos salido fortalecidos.

El agua vuelve a ser potable, las pruebas han finalizado y la seguridad de nuestro suministro de agua está garantizada. Gracias por cuidarse mutuamente y por su paciencia mientras trabajábamos para asegurar que cada gota cumpliera con los más altos estándares.

Sigamos adelante

Ahora puede volver a usar el agua del grifo para beber, cocinar y bañarse sin necesidad de tomar precauciones adicionales. El distrito continúa realizando los análisis de rutina semanales, por lo que le garantizamos que nuestra agua es de la mejor calidad posible. ¡Es hora de guardar las jarras y retomar sus rutinas habituales!

Lifeguard Positions: 2026 Summer Season

Seasonal Description

Be a part of all the fun that is happening at the Malaga County Water District Park and Recreation Department this summer! Malaga needs motivated and passionate individuals who are ready to be part of an exciting community. If you are looking to enhance your leadership experience, participate in team building, meet new and exciting people, and above all, positively impact the lives of our youth - WE HAVE THE JOB FOR YOU!

Malaga is gearing up for summer activities in AQUATICS - To be assigned to a pool, each candidate for this position will be required to complete and receive certification in Lifeguarding which includes CPR and first aid, provided by the Red Cross. The Red Cross training class and certification costs will be paid by the District.

Under supervision, LIFEGUARDS closely monitor pool area activities and swimmer safety; resuscitates and administers first-aid and CPR to swimmers and determines if medical care is necessary and notifies appropriate agency; may instruct in swimming, may assist with minor maintenance work in the pool area.

Pay, Benefits, & Work Schedule

Lifeguard: \$17.00 per hour

Working hours: Incumbents may be required to work approximately 30-40 hours per week, including weekends and holidays. Working hours may be between the hours of 1:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Malaga County Water District is seeking dedicated, responsive, and conscientious people to work. These are seasonal employment opportunities that do not provide health benefits or retirement and are not in any way a guarantee of permanent employment.

The Requirements

Applicants must meet the minimum qualifications on or before the posted filing deadline for further consideration: Previous experience in advanced swimming, lifesaving, or swim instruction is required, or enrollment in, or completion of, a recognized Junior Lifeguard program. All candidates will be required to attend a paid lifeguard training program and first aid class and receive/maintain necessary certifications as a condition of continued employment. All candidates will be required to pass a pre-employment drug screening and Livescan background check.
